INDIAN WEAVER was forwardly placed early, then closed, three wide and drew off for the win. NEWTONS THEORY was mid pack, on the rail, then rallied between horses and got up for second. JUBILAEM pressed the pace, offered a bid and held on for show to be the best of the rest. TEJANO CAT set the pressure pace and faded at the quarter pole. SHOWTIME DON had no early foot along the rail, angled out on the turn and had a mild rally. THE SHAUGHRAUN was near the back, four wide and passed tired ones. HEADED FOR HOME was mid field, three wide and faded in the stretch. GILDED PROMISE chased the pace, from the inside and retreated at the quarter pole. BOLD MEETING trailed the field, drifted six wide in the stretch and showed little.
