SHOULD pressed the pace, three wide, then made a bid to grab the win with a driving finish. GORILLA MOUNTAIN was mid field, on the rail, angled out at the eighth pole, then rallied and got up for second. HE'S A TOUGH DUDE was near the back and closed, five wide to get up for show. YIELD A WINNER vied for the lead down the backstretch, but faltered at the eighth pole. LASER FUZION dueled for the lead on the backstretch and gave way at the eighth pole. BANKER'S WAY was mid pack, angled out on the turn, five wide and showed a mild late effort. SUREFIRE SUCCESS stalked the pace, two wide, but faded in the stretch. STAFFHOUSE ROAD trailed the field, four wide and failed to menace. OCEAN JOE had no early foot, offered a mild bid in the turn, going four wide and retreated in the stretch.
