TRUSTEE TOM chased the pace, two wide, then closed and drew off late for the win. A LITTLE STORM KEY set the pace, opening up early, then flattened out down the lane and held on for second. LAMBSHEAD was in contention early, three wide, rallied and got up for third. DANG was mid pack, three wide, offered a mild bid but it was not enough. CHOPINS NOTE was mid field, going four to five wide, showed a mild effort around the turn, but hung in the lane. GETSETGETREADYGO was forwardly placed early along the inside, but dropped back at the three eighths pole. EMPIRE OF THE SUN had no early foot, four wide and lacked a late response. HE APPEARED was pulled up after the start and vanned off.
