INFINITE RESOURCE was allowed to settle, then made a steady gain between horses to get up late. QUIET AGAIN was forwardly placed early, then assumed command on the turn, and gave way grudgingly at the wire. MCKENNA'S JUSTICE was unhurried early, then angled out and rallied, four wide to get up for show. SCOREWITHCATER was mid pack, then angled out on the backstretch and rallied, five wide but it was not enough. BROTHER JOHN D. trailed the field, then angled out, five wide and closed. VAMOOSE was mid field, on the inside, offered a bid on the turn, but flattened out down the lane. SANTAQUIN chased the pace, then dropped back at the three eighths pole. FOX IN THE HOUSE had no early foot, three wide and passed tired foes. PIERRE BEAR set the pace, opening up, then faded at the three sixteenths pole. RIG'S RUNNER was in contention early, on the inside and retreated at the three eighths pole.
