MR. TRIESTE was unhurried early saving ground, vied into the stretch angling out three wide, closed with a rush under strong left handed urging and was clear late. SUSPICIOUS MINDS pressed the early pace from the inside, gained the advantage down the backstretch, was clear nearing the quarter pole and was turned away in the final strides. SKIP AND GO chased the early leaders, lacked a bid late and was no match for the top two. KOTUSPEEDING was allowed to settle early and placed a mild bid late. VENTURE CAT dropped back early and improved his position in the stretch. TOUCH THE WIRE raced mid pack and faded. NYCITY set a pressured early pace from the inside, was finished after a half and gave way. BILLY BIRD showed little in a dull effort.
