THE FORHAM FLUSH pressed the pace from inside of rivals, dueled in the final furlong and dug in to be just up under steady urging. DEVON ICE set a pressured pace from between horses, dueled in the final eighth of a mile and failed to match strides with the winner. CLAUDINE'S REVENGE forced the pace from the outside and lacked the late response needed. PULPIT AFFAIR chased the leaders three wide and lacked a solid late bid. SASSY TILL DAWN was unhurried early, raced widest in the stretch to improved her position. HOT BODY was allowed to settle into stride in the early going, angled three wide at the quarter pole, yielded in deep stretch. BARBARA DARLIN failed to threaten. CLICK ON GO broke slow and was never a factor. ABSOLUTELY CRYSTAL trailed throughout and was outrun.
