SASSY CHIMES raced wide into the first bend, moved up down the backstretch while still a bit wide, engaged the front with a sixteenth to go and proved best at the wire. MOM N DONNA moved well through traffic, got in tight quarters turning for home, made it through in deep stretch and just missed at the wire. DAYVONNA EXPRESS ranged up three wide on the backstretch, raced on even terms to the lane, gained a slight edge in the drive, but could not hold off the winner. CAL BRITE joined the front down the backstretch, drifted out a bit turning for home, dug in till the eighth pole, then faltered. SNAKES P J raced a bit wide, made some ground late. JANNY'S GIRL passed the tired ones late. ANALYZED set the fractions from the fence, battled to the second turn, was forced to check and lost momentum then faded. LISA'S BOUTIQUE was never a forward factor. X PRESS PASS showed little. ADVANCING POWER pushed out racing into the first turn and never recovered.
