ROSE AVENUE raced unhurriedly down the backstretch, came four wide through the turn, split foes early in the drive and was alertly angled out then in a well handled, game effort. TRUCKEE PRIDE set all the pace to the furlong pole, looked the winner at that point but could not hold off the fast closing ROSE AVENUE. SALSA DANCE tracked the leader two wide through the turn, remained a presence to deep stretch but could not reach the front. MAELSTROM was off awkwardly, raced very wide through the turn and closed with interest without menacing the top ones. BRAVE TALE came five wide through the turn and also closed evenly. SLEW FLY did not reach contention. PATY RAY was not a factor. NORTHERN PLANS chased the leaders to the stretch and stopped. CYNTHIA DAWN showed good brief speed and gave out.
