Footnotes

CONDITIONER flashed good speed, contested the pace while off the rail, drifted four wide into the stretch, kicked away to mid stretch then held driving. GALLANT VICTORY bobbled then bumped ALEVEL at the start, trailed to the turn, raced four wide to the stretch then finished in a rally while widest. JENNY'S FIRST GEAR chased the leaders to the turn, bid three then four wide to the stretch but finished evenly through the final furlong. ALEVEL stalked the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch but gave way in the drive. SHE B SUPER also chased the leaders, was between rivals to the stretch then also gave way. LA COLOMBINA was outrun to the turn, raced off the rail to the stretch and tired. REALLY A DUTCHESS was hustled to engage for the lead to the turn, got pushed out five wide by the winner into the stretch and gave out.
