BELL ZONE broke alertly and was on the pace from the outset, turned back GUADALUPE LUPE into the stretch, edged away to mid stretch then lugged out through the final furlong. GRILLN N CHILLN chased the pace to the turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch then finished willingly without threatening the winner. GUADALUPE LUPE attended the pace to the turn, offered his best try three wide to the stretch, was turned back by the winner and weakened late to relinquish the place. C'MON MARQUIS tracked the pace to the turn, was two wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. INDIAN WELLS stalked the leaders from the rail to the stretch but also failed to rally. SOUND OF MONEY shied away from RAPTOR FORCE in the chute and trailed to the turn, was four wide to the stretch but was never a threat. RAPTOR FORCE broke in and intimidated SOUND OF MONEY at the start, was sent up to get into contention on the backstretch but ran into traffic trouble, got shuffled back on the turn and stopped.
