MIDNITE IN KONA was quickly in front to set all of the pace, met a rail bid from MINISTER MEETING on the turn, turned back that rival once in the stretch and drew clear. MINISTER MEETING broke alertly and prompted the winner early, moved up inside that rival on the turn to challenge but proved no match once in the stretch. JAN THE FIRST was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn then split foes in the drive to gain the show. RIO BRILLA stalked the pace three wide to mid turn and gave out. TURBO POINT pressed the winner from the outside early but gave way readily. MUAH broke alertly but fell back steadily. SWORDLESS saved ground to no avail. LUV'N THAT CAT settled early within striking distance then gave way two wide on the turn.
