DUSTIN THE TRACK raced up after the break to vie for the lead inside J R'S RAIDER, disposed of that rival entering the stretch then drew off while not being asked for his best. THECATCHECKRAISED lacked good early speed, saved ground on the turn and finished steadily. ANDREW'S TURN was permitted to settle early, raced four wide on the turn but lacked the needed response. J. R.'S RAIDER dueled outside the winner into the stretch and slackened. CORONAS AT DELMAR settled early within striking distance but lacked a rally while three wide into the lane. RINGMASTER showed little in a dull effort. DIXIE BANKER lagged early, raced off the rail into the stretch but went evenly through the drive. DEPUTY DAN stalked the winner early but failed to respond while two wide into the stretch. MARK TREY saved ground to no avail. IM PURE COUNTRY raced close up early from the outside but faded once on the turn.
