Footnotes

DA BOMB was reserved off the leaders early under patient handling, was forced to rally four wide on the turn to catch the leaders, took a narrow lead nearing the furlong pole and held driving. ADVANCE TICKET tracked the pace from the outset, moved up inside PEEK A BOOP to challenge for the lead at the quarter pole, dueled the winner to the furlong pole then gradually weakened. PEEK A BOOP rushed up after the start and set the pace from off the rail, remained a factor into the stretch then slackened. HIGH TUNE raced unhurried early, came three wide to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MOST POPULAR pressed the pace between horses to the turn and gave way. GOT TOBE RIO stalked the pace three wide to mid turn then had little left.
