TRIPP TO GLORY stalked the leaders in hand to the turn, was fanned out four deep while rallying to the stretch, inched away to mid stretch then was all out to hold off ASIAN EYES late. ASIAN EYES The latter contested the pace to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch, was outgunned to mid stretch but kept to task in the final stages and just missed. YOUNG AND FRESH was among the leaders early then dropped back while four wide on the turn, remained out five deep to the stretch then could not make an impact in the late going. LA MISTERIOSA had no speed, was three wide to the stretch then failed to threaten late. HOUSE OF CRYSTAL set the pace from well off the rail to the turn, was roused mid turn, remained a factor to mid stretch then gave out.
