**Footnotes**

CLARE'S TOP CHOICE stalked the leaders to the turn, saved ground to the stretch, had plenty of room inside, rallied when set down and pushed clear driving. MY CHARMING CHANCE stalked the pace to the turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch, was outkicked by the winner through the final furlong but kept to task late and was up for second. FLIP THE PENNY was used early and dueled for the lead to the turn, came two wide to the stretch, responded to urging and resisted to mid stretch then stayed on after being passed by the winner and just failed to hold the place. SEAFIRE had no speed and chased the pace, bid three wide into the turn, got pushed out five deep into the stretch then finished willingly through the final sixteenth. I'M THE IRISH MAN chased the pace to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch but could not muster the needed late response. WARREN'S HOT STUFF was hustled early and dueled outside of FLIP THE PENNY, was pushed out three deep to the stretch then tired through the final furlong. ALABAMA BOY had no speed and was not a factor.
