Footnotes

WESTERN ROSES was on the pace while off the rail to the second turn, pushed away from CROWN OF ARAGORN in upper stretch then lugged out from a left handed whipping in mid stretch but straightened quickly and held driving. CROWN OF ARAGORN was on the pace outside the winner for five furlongs, came two wide to the stretch, got outkicked and forced out a bit in mid stretch, weakened late and just saved the place. GHOST REIGN chased the pace to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch then could not threaten the winner and just missed second. STEFANELLI had no speed, trailed to the second turn then saved ground but lacked a closing response. STEEL BLUE was four wide on the first turn, settled to the half, attempted a rally three deep to the stretch but was giving way late. MOSCATO was three wide to the backstretch, bid two wide into the second turn, gave way in the drive then pulled up shortly after the finish line and was vanned off.
