BRITE JUDY was unhurried for a half mile, rallied three wide on the second turn, pushed up to duel to mid stretch then inched away under steady urging. YALETOWN chased the leader to the second turn, moved up to engage for the lead two wide, resisted the winner to mid stretch then weakened but saved second. HELM'S MAGIC lagged to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch and was making up ground belatedly. SIMPLY SECRET chased the pace to the second turn then saved ground but weakened in the drive. CAUSE UR A TEN sped clear, set the pace to the second turn, was collared into the stretch and tired through the lane. MILLENNIUM BREW settled mid pack to the second turn then gave out.
