PERFECT VERVE was content to track for the opening quarter, moved up to engage for the lead leaving the five eighths, dueled outside of LOBO DEL DESIERTO on the second turn, disposed of that one into the stretch, edged away to mid stretch and held driving. CORN MAZE was unhurried for a half mile, commenced a bid three wide on the second turn, did not pose a threat to the winner in the drive but was best of the rest. DR. EVIL was settled to the half, came two wide on the second turn but could not muster the needed response. STORMY FRANK pressed the pace to the second turn, offered a good bid three wide to the stretch but faded in the drive. LOBO DEL DESIERTO set the pace for a half mile, briefly contended with the winner on the second turn then weakened. LINEMAN chased the pace four wide for five furlongs then tired. BIG ROCK CANDI trailed throughout, bore out into the stretch then was eased in the drive but walked off.
