Footnotes

TAHOE FLASH was quick from the gate to sprint clear, turned back TORNADO RED into the turn to gain draw clear, took his longest lead at the furlong pole but just managed to last. TWO SCOTCH BLUES settled early, advanced two wide on the turn, dropped inside to rally in the lane, eased out nearing the wire and just missed from between horses. TORNADO RED lacked good speed from the gate but rushed up inside into the turn to briefly challenge the winner, was shuffled back nearing the three eighths and shifted outside, then responded in the drive and just missed from the outside. MYSTICAL MARK stalked the winner three wide early, came on in the lane but checked off TWO SCOTCH BLUES at the finish. TYME CHAMP saved ground to no avail. MONET was always outrun.
