### Footnotes

TRIBAL SKY was outprinted early then moved up inside nearing the five eighths to engage for the lead, dueled from the rail to the stretch, disposed of DOC CAN DANCE leaving mid stretch and was clear to the sixteenth then just held on. SURFER DAVE was unhurried to the half, bid two wide on the second turn, shifted out into the stretch then closed ground willingly but was too late. DOC CAN DANCE prompted the pace for a half mile, was up alongside the winner to duel two wide to the stretch, stayed on to mid stretch then was tiring late. HOT TUB AARON had no speed, raced three or four wide throughout and lacked a closing response. RAZZ ATTACK chased the pace for a half, bid three wide on the second turn but gave way through the drive. JUGADOR had the best speed and led into the first turn then was under a stout hold by the rider which allowed the others to move up, remained a factor to the second turn but stopped after six furlongs, was eased in the stretch but walked off.
