DURER was well placed under light restraint to the thirteenth jump, responded when asked on the far turn, dueled briefly into the stretch, drew off quickly before the fourteenth jump and proved much the best. TIME OFF was unhurried while trailing on the first circuit, steadily advanced to loom boldly at the thirteenth jump but had no response when the winner drew away. CLASSIC BRIDGES rated kindly through the first circuit, steadily advanced to gain command midway on the second backstretch but couldn't match strides with the winner in the upper stretch. EZ MAC was rated to the third turn, steadily advanced to loom a factor into the far turn but then gave way. SOUTHERN ADMIRAL dueled through the first circuit, weakened after the eleventh jump and was pulled up after the thirteenth jump. SAINT NICHOLAS dueled on the first turn circuit, drew clear, stumbled over the eleventh fence and fell.
