

CUSE CUSE was ridden to a long lead, responded well to HISTORY BOY's challenge nearing the stretch and held safe that one under a long drive. HISTORY BOY was rated on the first circuit, slowly whittled the winner's margin to look like a winner at the middle of the stretch but couldn't get passed CUSE. ON THE CORNER was rated on the first circuit and no rally after that. UNION ARMY trailed. CLASSIC BRIDGES rated through the first circuit, rallied to the ninth jump and then fell at the twelfth.
