ITS LAUNCH TIME set a pressured pace on the rail, opened a lead in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and finished gamely. MR SLATE raced evenly to the outside, gained steadily in the second turn, rallied into the stretch, got through on the rail and closed well. PAPA TIME was shuffled back at the start, saved ground then gained in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and finished well. SUSPENSE AT LAST pressed the lead to the outside but weakened at the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. RODS CHOICE chased the leader, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and gained ground. UNWAVERING ROAR entered the turn wide and was taken back to chase the lead but weakened along the backstretch. REGAL ROSETTI saved ground, raced evenly and was not a factor. ROCKY MILWAUKEE was off slowly and never threatened. DIAMOND DOC drifted out into the first turn, dropped back and trailed.
