RONALDINO dueled to the inside of LAKETON, opened a led in mid stretch and finished ridden out. LAKETON dueled to the outside of RONALDINO but weakened in mid stretch and finished second best. SIR GALLANT stalked the leaders on the rail and finished evenly. TEJANO TROUBLE broke outward at the start, raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and gained ground. IDIDN'TDOANYTHING was bothered at the start, dropped back to trail then rallied into the stretch, got through on the rail and closed well late. HOT WIRED saved ground, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. PLAGIARIST was bothered at the start, stalked the leaders to the outside but weakened after the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch
