Footnotes

PLAGIARIST raced close up, bid three wide in the second turn, vied for the lead from three wide into the stretch, led late and just lasted. CHURCHBRIDGE raced close up on the rail, rallied four wide in the upper stretch, closed well and just missed. VESTED IN SLEW set a pressured pace on the rail, vied for the lead on the rail in the second turn, rallied but was outfinished. SPARHAWK pressed the pace on the outside, made a bid in the second turn, vied for the lead from between horses in the second turn but weakened. BEAU BRASS was carried out in the first turn, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well. FLY ESTEEM stalked the pace on the rail but flattened out in the stretch. CANDID REMARK was slow early, saved ground, gained ground in the second turn and showed a mild rally in the upper stretch. TIGER ENERGY was wide early, raced three wide along the backstretch, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. THAT'S AN OUTRAGE drifted out entering the first turn, gained ground along the backstretch, raced four wide and tired in the stretch.
