Footnotes

ROLLETTI was forced wide entering the first turn, gained ground, bid in the second turn, rally three wide into the stretch and prevailed. I'M SLICK TWO drifted out entering the first turn, gained ground steadily, rallied four wide into the stretch and finished evenly. LITTLE GENERAL was slow early, raced evenly, rallied four wide into the stretch and finished well. PART PIRATE was forced out entering the first turn, made a bid in the backstretch, dueled with ROLLETTI but weakened in the stretch and faded. KAT DESIGN saved ground, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide in the stretch and gained ground. TROUBLEONTHEBENCH lacked speed, raced evenly, rallied five wide into the stretch and gained ground. MR SLATE was off slowly, raced to the outside, gained ground in the second turn but flattened out in the stretch. BENT TUNE was slow early, raced evenly, rallied into the upper stretch and gained ground late. REMARKABLE NORTH drifted out entering the first turn, dueled along the backstretch but weakened after the quarter pole and tired. TOBY BAY was forced wide entering the first turn and was taken back to race along the rail but weakened in the second turn and dropped back.
