SHE'S TWENTY BELOW stalked the pace to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and closed well. Q TEE Q vied for the lead on the rail, opened a lead in the second turn, rallied into the stretch, ran gamely but weakened late. DAWN OF FAME was three wide into the first turn, was taken back, raced evenly and rallied three wide in the upper stretch and finished well. DESPERATELYDANDY entered the first turn four wide early, was taken back to race evenly and rallied in the stretch to finished well. DIXIETWOSTEPPER stalked the pace on the rail, weakened in the second turn and finished evenly. REGAL MAGI hit the gate and angled out then rushed to stalk the pace from three wide but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. O MY DEAR was bumped at the start, pressed the pace to the outside but weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. REPOSE was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide and gained ground late..
