Footnotes

TANIKA stalked the leaders to the outside, bid for wide into the third turn, dueled with SHE'S ITALIAN in the stretch and was all out to prevailed. SHE'S ITALIAN dueled to the outside of DIXIETWOSTEPPER, led late in the third turn, dueled with TANIKA in the stretch but was outfinished. DEBIE GINSBURG was in tight early and was taken back, gained ground steadily, rallied into the stretch and closed well. The rider on DEBIE GINSBURG claimed foul on TANIKA for interference entering the first turn. The claim of foul was not allowed. TSARMINA was three wide early, raced evenly on the rail, rallied upper in the stretch and finished well. SPEEDY GONE SALLY was taken back early to stalk the pace on the rail but weakened along the backstretch and finished evenly. BRAETTA taken was taken back early, trailed, showed a mild rally and finished evenly. DIXIETWOSTEPPER dueled to the inside of SHE'S ITALIAN but weakened in the third turn and dropped back in the stretch. BANJO BABE was caught three wide early and was taken back to the rail, stalked the leaders, made a bid on the rail entering the third turn but gave way.
