CHURCHBRIDGE raced to the outside early, gained ground steadily, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, rallied and drew clear in mid stretch. CANDID REMARK chased the leaders from the rail, bid for the lead in the 3rd turn, rallied briefly and weakened in the upper stretch but held on for the place. ROYALTY BOY broke sharply and saved ground, rallied 3 wide in the upper stretch and finished well. NUGRAYONTHEBLOCK was off slowly, trailed, gained steadily along the backstretch, rallied 4 wide in the upper stretch but flattened out late. CINDERCHANCE raced evenly on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch and ran evenly late. FOREVER RASCAL chased the leaders on the rail, gained ground along the backstretch, was 3 wide in the upper stretch and tired. MOOLAH BASKET pressed the pace from the rail, bid for the lead in the 2nd turn, set a pressured pace, weakened in the 3rd turn and dropped back in the stretch. GOLDEN HUNT broke sharply, set the early pace, weakened at the 1/4 pole, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
