MY GUY dueled on the rail with TOP AUTHORITY, opened a slight lead in mid stretch, held on gamely and just lasted. TOP AUTHORITY dueled to the outside of MY GUY, was headed at mid stretch but closed late and just missed. NAPINOWAAN was slow early, raced evenly and outfinished others. FORCEFUL INTENTION stalked the leaders on the rail, weakened in the 3rd turn and faded. CHA CHARM was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the 3rd turn and flattened out in the stretch. BELL N' GONE stalked the leaders to the outside, weakened in the 3rd turn and dropped back. BETHUNE raced wide early, drifted out in the first turn, was steadied, dropped back and trailed. TEAGUES FIGHT was 4 wide early, stalked the leaders but weakened at the 3/8 pole and gave way.
