BRIARS FLASH raced four wide early, gained ground steadily, rallied four wide into the stretch and closed steadily. TOKA set the pace, rallied in the upper stretch but weakened in mid stretch and held place. KISSNRIDE broke in the air, rushed to contention on the outside, rallied three wide in the stretch but faded late. INFINITE STRIKE raced evenly to the outside, rallied into the upper stretch and finished well. DIVA VANEVA stalked the lead on the rail but weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. SMART N SEXY stalked the lead to the outside, made a bid in the second turn but flattened out in the stretch. EXECUTIVE CHEYENNE saved ground, raced evenly and faded. TIME INCLUDED was slow early, trailed and was never a factor.
