Footnotes

INSTANTLY set a pressured pace on the rail, drew clear after the quarter pole and drew off in the stretch. DUAL FUEL lacked early speed, raced evenly, gained ground while three wide, rallied four wide into the stretch and finished well for the place. TYABERING raced wide early, stalked the lead to the outside, dropped back in the third turn, rallied into the stretch and finished well. ONENEVERKNOWS was slow early, raced evenly, bid three wide into the second turn, stalked the leaders but dropped back in the third turn and flattened out in the stretch. LIGHT OF GOLD pressed the lead to the outside but weakened in the third turn and dropped back in the stretch. CHURCHBRIDGE was shuffled back along the rail after the start, gained ground in the backstretch, stalked the leaders but weakened entering the third turn and faded.
