DIXIETWOSTEPper stalked REGAL MAGI on the rail, was blocked in the second turn, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, rakkied and closed well. BELLE PRIDE drifted out in the first turn, raced close up to the outside, bid three wide in the second turn, rallied four wide into the stretch but was outfinished. DESPERATELYDANDY lacked speed, saved ground, gained in the second turn, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and finished evenly. RIBBON CREEK raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide into the stretch and gained ground. SALLYINTHEALLEY pressed REGAL MAGI on the outside but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. REGAL MAGI set a pressured pace, weakened in the upper stretch and faded.
