MR MUFFIN MAN dueled to the inside of NORM'S AT CHEERS and prevailed. NORM'S AT CHEERS dueled to the outside but was outfinished. RAINBOW STEW chased the leaders on the rail, raced evenly, showed a mild rally but failed to gain in the stretch. SHEEPY was three wide early, raced evenly then gained along the backstretch but flattened out. UP GRADER saved ground, raced evenly then gained ground in the second turn but angled out in the upper stretch and finished evenly. HAWKERS GATE was off slowly and shuffled back, saved ground and was no factor. ASHESINTHEWIND drifted out entering the first turn, continued to the outside and gave way.
