ZURI MWANA dueled to the outside of OH WHO KNOWS, opened a short lead late in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and held well. LITTLE GENERAL chased the leaders on the rail, gained ground steadily, rallied three wide in the upper stretch but was outfinished. AIRO FAITH drifted out a bit entering the first turn, chased the leaders to the outside, gained ground in the backstretch and made a mild rally from three wide. HONEST BREW lacked speed, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and gained ground. OH WHO KNOWS broke sharply, dueled to the inside of ZURI MWANA but weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. THAT'S A GOOD BOY drifted very wide entering the first turn, raced evenly and dropped back steadily in the stretch.
