ANDREA ALLSTAR chased the early leader from the rail into the turn, eased out slightly to the outside of that rival leaving turn then wore down the runner-up in the final seventy yards. WAVERING THOUGHT was hustled clear, set the pace on the rail then finished willingly to no avail. BLONDY'S HONOR was never far back, moved into the four path into the stretch then continued to gain steadily. BRAVE OPPONENT was put to the whip early, chased two wide but lacked a closing punch. WANNA KAT was never too far back, raced in the four path leaving then turn then continued with an even effort. AUNT LYNNIE was off a step slow, saved ground along the turn and only had belated speed. VALE OF TEARS chased from the rail into the turn, couldn't keep pace and tired. PACIFIC ECHO chased from the outside, came widest into the stretch and tired. LADY OF REIGN was off a step slow then never seriously involved racing in the three path. CHURN showed brief speed inside rivals, had nothing left into the stretch and tired.
