REIGN ROSE was off a step slow, was allowed to race well back, rallied two wide along the far turn, eased out a bit in upper stretch and closed strongly outside. DOREL never far back, rallied along the rail far turn, angled out entering upper stretch, and continued gamely but couldn't contain the winner. LITTLE MISS HURRY showed the way, battled into upper stretch and grudgingly gave way to the top two. BIDASWEET unhurried, raced along the rail throughout then made a mild gain far turn, but lacked a strong closing response. L P ENSIGN stalked the leaders, was three wide final turn, drifted out at the top of the stretch and weakened. RE A FAX pressed the pace two wide, gave way far bend, tired and was eased at the finish.
