NORTH EAST BELLE stalked to the turn, closed outside the leader in midstretch then was kept to steady urging. JONATHONS GAL was off a step slow, saved ground into the turn, swung out leaving the turn and closed game for the place. SHE'S ON HER TOES was hustled clear early and gained the rail, showed the way into the lane but was empty in the final furlong. EASY GREETING was never far back and chased from the three path but had no late punch. MILLENNIUM SUN well placed to the turn, couldn't keep pace and tired. STORM FEVER, in contention to the turn, steadily retreated and tired. BLAZ'N PENNY off step slow, chased outside, taken to rail, tired.
