EXPENSIVE VERDICT was rated along the inside while not far back, angled out entering the stretch then closed outside and reached the front late. BUT WHAT HYACINTH was rated within easy striking distance three wide, moved to the front midway on the final turn then gave way in the stretch. REPRICED FAME steadied along the rail entering the far turn, stayed inside and gained once clear. DR MARGARET bobbled at the break then quickly recovered to gain position three wide and weakened. JULIE'SISTER made the pace inside for about six furlongs then stopped. CONLUA showed speed two wide for over a half then stopped. CLASSY INDEED showed little and was eased. I'M A PRINCESS TOO was always far back and was eased.
