NANCY'S SPIRIT settled inside, circled rivals four wide along the far turn then surged clear late under strong urging. ASSETS OF GOLD stalked three wide, was clear into upper stretch but couldn't last. SPANISH LADY unhurried saving ground, rallied along the rail around the far turn and bested the rest. MICHELLE'S DIAMOND was hustled to command, went clear into the final bend then steadily weakened. LADY IRENE chased inside, threat to stretch, tired. HIGHLAND SKIRT four wide into first turn, chased to final turn, tired. JEWEL ALARM taken off rail into backstretch, chased to far turn, tired. CRUZAN MIDNIGHT four wide into first turn, gave way leaving backstretch, tired.
