JADE PALACE was hustled clear early, set the pace near or on the rail throughout and was kept to steady urging to remain safe. GREEN GINGHAM GIRL, well placed three wide, gained the rail into the far turn then closed late for the place. JOLIE GOOD settled inside, swung out four wide into the stretch, drifted inward a bit in deep stretch then was outfinished for the place. GOLD N FANCY chased saving ground, made a mild gain from the outside then continued evenly late. MIESQUE'S ABROJO stalked the winner from the two path throughout then steadied slightly late while weakening. OUR REVIVAL, four wide first turn, forwardly placed to the stretch then tired. MISS I. Q. was off a step slow, saved ground throughout, outrun. BRIEFCASE GIRL three path early, never menaced, tired.
