### Footnotes

BEHRENS was rated within easy striking position while in the four path, was sent up to duel on the final turn while still well out into the track and wore down RUNNING STAG in late stretch. RUNNING STAG was put in front soon after the break, stayed out from the rail while setting the pace under rating, responded readily when challenged on the final turn, drifted in late and faltered. REAL QUIET was rated between the top two early, gave his best into the final turn, fell back and dropped to the rail nearing the stretch and tired. BRUSHING UP was carried out while unhurried into the first turn, angled to the rail soon after then made up some ground through the final quarter. GALLOPING GAEL was unhurried after a sharp start, stayed close early and tired. PERSONAL MOON ran out entering the first turn then fell far back.
