LET IT BE HARDYBOY contested pace inside, battled for place, game try for minors. EASTER BUNNY outrun to turn, five path leaving turn, improved position. WAX ON WAX OFF vied for lead three wide to turn, two wide off turn, tired. GOODNIGHT BRAD forced pace outside to turn, three wide on turn, tired. SKYNYRD attended pace five abreast, four wide into turn, tired. NINE MILLIMETER battled two wide, between rivals to turn, gave way, empty.
