RITZY DAME was close up inside the leaders, made a bid two wide off the turn and closed willingly late. FUHRLINE was hustled to command, battled between rivals late and weakened in the final sixteenth. BEAUTIFUL LASSIE stalked to the turn, raced just outside the leaders then had no late response. JONATHONS GAL off step slow, unhurried two wide, failed to menace. BRATTLE SQUARE chased four wide, five path off turn, weakened. MY BABY GIRL in contention to turn, three wide, no stretch punch. DAFFODIL PRINCESS brief speed, two path to rail turn, tired. SWINGSVILLE hustled early, four wide chasing leaders, tired.
