Footnotes

ELUSIVE SON rated in the middle of the pack between horses to the second turn, rallied into the stretch, split the leaders in the final furlong, was courageous in bulling his way between the leaders a sixteenth out and was up three jumps out. The stewards posted the Inquiry sign, reviewed the incident near the sixteenth pole and allowed the result to stand. STEP BROTHER was well placed early, rallied into the second turn, bid for the lead a furlong out, gained a short lead inside the final sixteenth and just missed. DOUBLE DANCER quickly took command, increased his lead to the second turn, responded gamely when challenged a furlong out, bore out a sixteenth out and weakened. ANONYMOUS DONOR was outrun on the outside and was no threat with a belated rally. LT. KOJAK raced in the middle of the pack and had a mild rally. ADVANCEANDRETREAT stalked the pack to near the second turn and tired. CARISTO had brief speed three-wide into the first turn. GET OFF THE STOOP was outrun. TELL GRANT trailed.
