MAX'S PAL chased the early pace while in hand two wide, rallied on the turn and gained command three wide at the top of the stretch then drew clear late while kept to task. MAKIN PROGRESS was allowed to settle then rallied four wide on the turn, was gaining ground in the stretch to be second best. MARKUS chased the pace from the inside while being settled, rallied on the inside on the turn then flattened out in the drive. BINNIFACTOR showed good early speed and set a very fast pace for the opening half, drew clear down the backstretch then stopped on the turn. LAKE PONTCHARTRAIN took a bad step at the 5/8 pole when going lame in his right front, was pulled up by his rider soon after and was vanned off.
