MR. B. W. sent clear from outside, drew off, drifted stretch, driving. HELLO D. NGATA chased three wide on turn, closed gap late, no threat. VIRTUES UNDER FIRE in close contention two wide, faded upper stretch, weakened. LONG HILL GLIDER broke through gate, four wide to turn, moved in two wide, faded. COBRA CLASSIC off step slow, inside into turn, angled wide, no bid. KAYDEE'S FLYER attended pace from inside, gave way upper stretch, tired. TIN STAR in contention five wide to turn, no response four wide, tired. FLYING SON prompted pace four wide into turn, gave way, tired. MO DULAR moved inside along backstretch, no menacing bid, tired.
