LAPANTALONES FANCE broke well to press the pace on the first turn, rallied into the second turn to duel for the lead before the quarter pole, drew clear in the upper stretch and was all out to last. DAMN STRAIGHT was squeezed back at the start and rushed outside, steadily advanced to the stretch, was fanned four-wide into the stretch, continued resolute in pursuit of the winner and just missed. MZ MILL raced in the middle of the pack, fanned five-wide rallying into the stretch and finished well. TO IT AND FROM IT stalked the pace on the inside, then out from the rail, bid between leaders into the stretch but failed to sustain his bid. RICH'S SPITFIRE was well placed, angled in on the second turn and tired. MARCH BACK TO ME quickly took command, set the pace to the stretch and tired. ADIRONDACK SKY raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. PROUD INK was no threat. MISS GLORY was well placed between horses early, bore out into the first turn and trailed. UPTOWN CHARMER was outrun.
