HI POPPY, three wide early, made a four wide bid off the far turn then surged clear late won going away. ROME IS BURNING was unhurried near or on the inside, rallied inside into the stretch and was just up for the place. EPISODE ON TOUR up close outside, raced three wide into the stretch, led to the sixteenth marker then yielded. STRIKE YOUR COLORS chased two wide early, lost contact into far turn, evenly. THEATRICAL TALENT well placed inside, swung out five into stretch, needed more. I'M A DILEMMA sent to command, set pace just off rail, weakened late. WATCHTOWER (IRE) four wide early, moved out six wide into stretch, weakened. MAD SCATTER moved out wide into backstretch, loomed three wide, tired.
