WHERE WE LEFT OFF (GB), forwardly placed and two wide throughout, went to command when asked for run leaving the far turn then drew off under mild urging once clear. LAREDO LIL was hustled to command and along the hedge setting the pace, was no match for the winner then stayed on well to hold the place. HALEY'S CLASSIC, never far back and saving all ground on the turns closed game for a share. KIMSTER was off a step slow, raced three wide throughout stalking the leaders but needed more late. SUNLIT RIDGE settled inside early, eased out leaving final turn, not enough. DANIA BAY in close contention along the rail, chased into lane, weakened. RIZZI GIRL off step slow, trailed saving ground early, faded three wide. PAR GOLFER never far back, two wide first turn, lacked closing response. PICTURE GALLERY two wide early, never seriously involved.
